

NEW MEXICO RESEARCH GRANT HIGH PRIORITY FALL 2016 SCORESHEET

BACKGROUND: TWENTY-FIVE (25) POINTS

- 1. Research is described in detail: What exactly the applicant will do, where and when it is happening, and why it is necessary for the applicant'sinterests? (0–10)
- 2. Applicant's academic/professional interests and stage in degree program are clearly stated and explicitly linked to the student's current and future goals. (θ5)
- 3. Research is put into context of the applicant's academic/professional fieldat large. (0–10)

BENEFITS: THIRTY-FIVE (35) POINTS

- 1. Benefits of research to applicant are clearly stated and linked to academic/professional development (0-10)
- 2. Benefits to the University of New Mexico, academic/professional community, and soiety are clearly stated. (0–15)
- 3. Benefits to specific New Mexican communities are explained.(0–10)

BUDGET: THIRTY (30) POINTS

- 1. Applicant pursued other legitimate sources of funding. (OR 5)
- 2. Sources of funding are shown for each line item in the budget. (OR 5)
- 3. Budget is well researched and complete for the scope of the project (names of facilities, dates, itineraries, etc.) listing all spending related to activity. (0-15)
- 4. Budget choices appear to be economical, and all high cost items are explained. (5)

COMPOSITION: TEN (10) POINTS

- 1. Writing style is direct, explicit, clear and free of grammatical errors. (0–5)
- 2. Proposal is suitable for a general academic audience and technical terms are defined. (0–5)

LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION: TWENTY (20) POINTS

- 1. Letter indicates faculty support of the project and support for the student's research endeavors. (0–10)
- 2. Letter from New Mexico agency¹ articulates the collaboration between the applicant and the state agency; state agency representative indicates support of the project. (θ10)

TOTAL: ONE HUNDRED-TWENTY (120) POINTS

¹ Bylaws IX. Section 2.E.3: "A New Mexico State agency, non-profit, or non-governmental organization that directly benefits and is based in the State of New Mexico. Cannot include the University of New Mexico and its branches."
