

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT GRANT SCORE SHEET

BACKGROUND: Twenty (20) POINTS

- Applicant's academic/professional interests are clearly stated. (0 or 5 points)
- Professional goals clearly stated (0 or 5 points)

Activity is described in detail. This is further divided up among the following:

- What exactly will the applicant do? (0-5points)
- Where and when is the activity happening? (0-5 points)

BENEFITS: Forty (40) POINTS

- Specific benefit(s) is clearly stated and explained (0-10 points)
- Proposed activity's benefits to applicant are clearly linked to professional development and/or career goals. (0-15 points)
- Activity put into context of academic/professional field (0-5 points)
- How is it significant for the applicant's goals? (0-10 points)

COMPOSITION: Ten (10) POINTS

- Proposal flows logically and writing is clear. (0-5) points
- Proposal is suitable for a general academic audience. Technical terms are defined. (0-5 points)

BUDGET: THIRTY (30) POINTS

- Applicant pursued other sources of funding within the university or academic community (0 OR 5)
- Budget has been completed using GPSA template (0 or 10)
- Budget appears well-researched and complete for scope of project (0 or 15)

TOTAL: ONE HUNDRED (100) POINTS
